
The workjobs included can be photocopied or duplicated directly onto con-struction paper or manilla tag. Instructions are included for each and are easy to follow. Ask a parent

to help you cut and color.


The Center Book pages are for creative development. Each child can create a booklet of his or her dinosaur studies.

Dinosaurs are a facinating topic for children of all ages. Have fun exploring, discovering and creating!










