

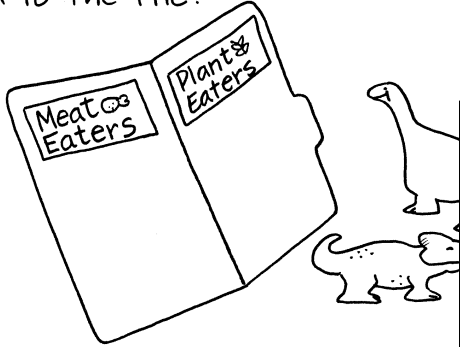
CLASSIFICATION

Meat Eaters, Plant Eaters

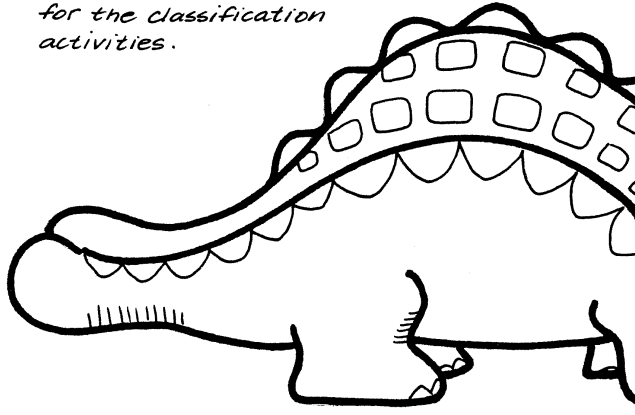
Student Objective : to classify plant eaters and meat eaters.

You'll need 1 legal size file folder (yellow), crayons, glue, scissors, a zipclose bag.

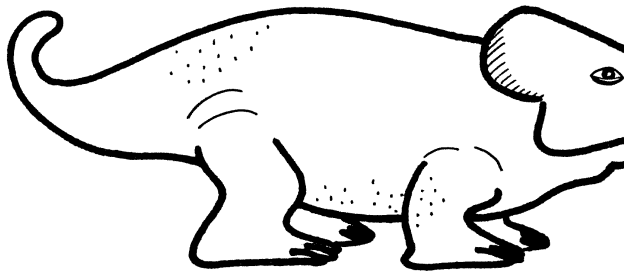
1. Duplicate the dinosaurs onto light green construction paper. Cut out and laminate. Or ... color the dinosaurs and mount on 2 ply bristol, cut out again leaving a 1/4" bristol border.
2. Color and cutout title picture. Glue on the outside of the file.
3. Color and cut out the classification illustrations. Glue one on each side of the inside of the file. Laminate the file folder.
4. Store the dinosaurs in a zipclose bag. Attach to the file.

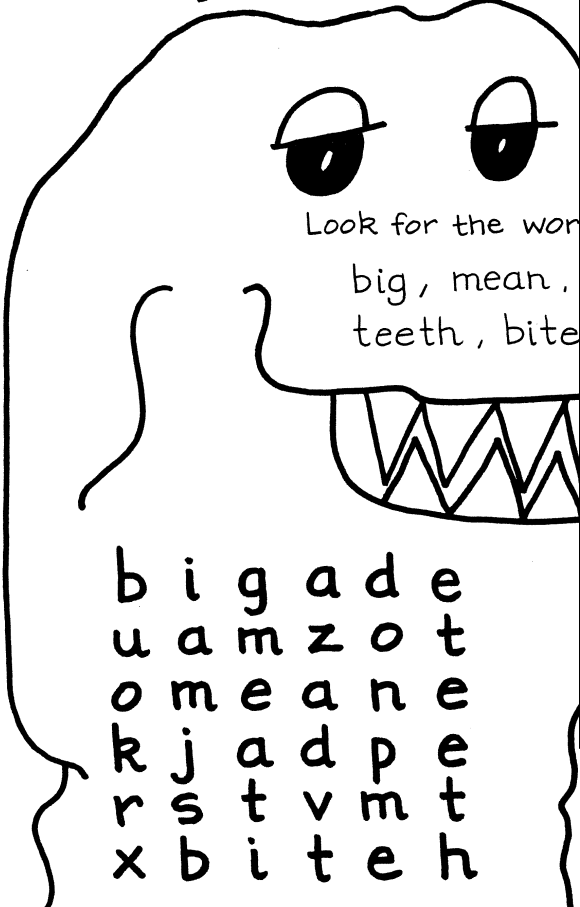

Student Objective: to put together the pieces to make a dinosaur.

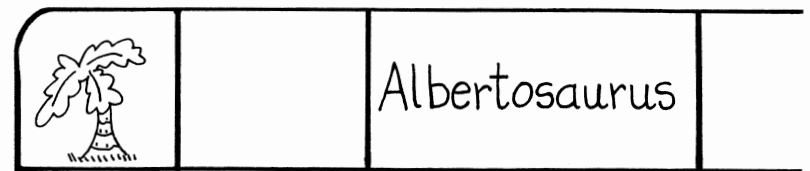
You'll need: 6 sheets of light green construction paper, 6 sheets of orange, crayons or markers, glue, scissors.

Copy Tyrannosaurus Rex onto the construction paper, the Stegosaurus on the orange. Laminate.

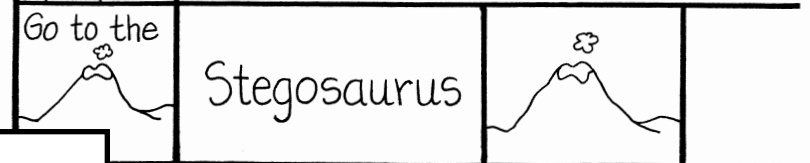
Color the puzzle pictures and glue them to the construction paper. Don't leave any pieces out.

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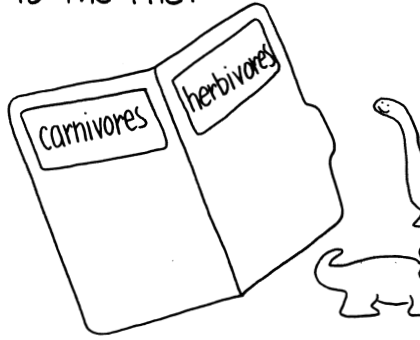
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Carnivores, herbivores

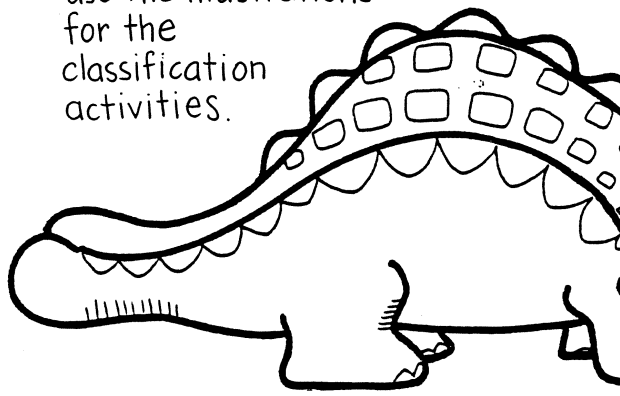
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2. Color and cutout title picture. Glue on the outside of the file.

4. Store the dinosaurs in a zipclose bag. Attach to the file.



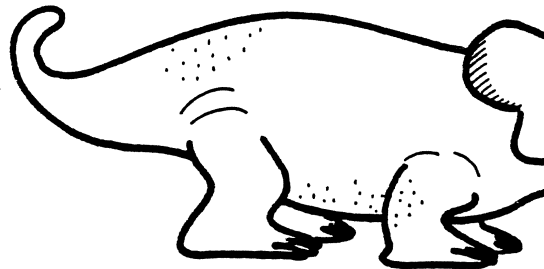
