

## MAJOR PROJECT – CITY PROPOSAL

Each student, pair of students, or small group of students choose a city in the world that interests them to create a “bid” to the IOC. The students want the IOC to pick their city to hold an Olympic Games in. They can decide whether they want to hold the Summer Olympics or the Winter Olympics in their city.
