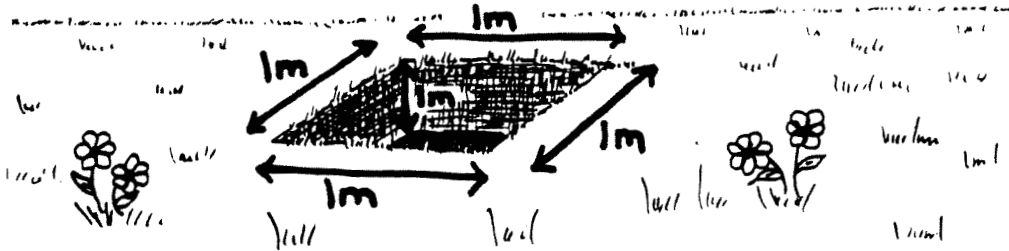


## PUZZLES #2

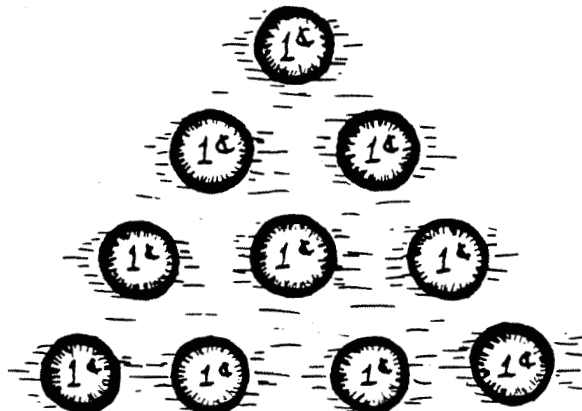

## DIFFICULT PUZZLES

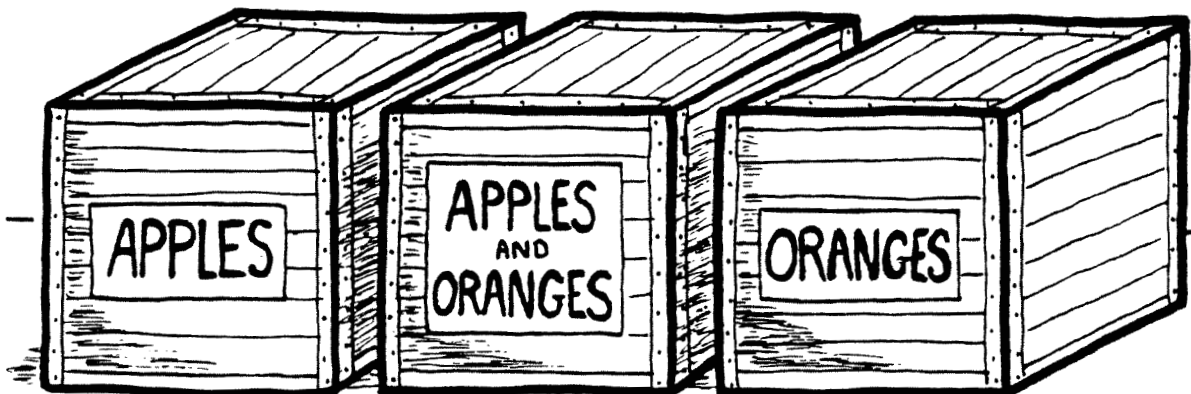
### 1. "The Cook"
